Wolf Elective Adventure: Digging in the Past

Note: <u>This guide will help your Scout group prepare to complete the "Digging in the Past"</u>
<u>Adventure Loop requirements at the new Wild Adventures Dinosaur Explore Exhibit</u>. These activities could be completed during the April 19-21, 2024 Scout Weekend or during another day when Wild Adventures and the Dinosaur Explore exhibit are open.

To Be Completed at Wild Adventures Dinosaur Explore Exhibit:

- 1. Play a game that demonstrates your knowledge of dinosaurs. Examples include:
 - Find 5 carnivores and 5 herbivores
 - Find 10 facts about dinosaurs
 - Play "I Spy" or "20 Questions" dinosaur style
- 2. Create an imaginary dinosaur. Share with your den its name, what it eats, and where it lives.
- 3. Make a dinosaur dig at the Dino Dig site within the Dinosaur Explore Exhibit. Be a paleontologist, and dig through the dinosaur dig made by another member of your den. Show and explain the ways a paleontologist works carefully during a dig.

To Be Completed at Wild Adventures Outside the Dinosaur Explore Exhibit on Your Own:

4. Make edible fossil layers. Explain how this snack is a good model for the formation of fossils. Examples include a layered ICEE from Jungle ICEE or pudding with crushed oreos at home.
